#### **SUNDAY, June 28**

Team Leon (lay-OWN) in Guanajuato (wahn-ah-WHAH-toe), Mexico, reports that last fall a man heard the Gospel, was given a Bible, and for a while seemed interested in the things of the Lord. Recently, he contacted the team and is now eagerly engaged in Bible study and discipleship. God answered your prayer that He would raise up men to serve Him in this city. Continue to pray with Team Leon that the Lord will move in the hearts of people.

#### **MONDAY, June 29**

In 2008 you prayed for the salvation of one million Cubans. Praise God that many responded! This year is "The Year of Unity for the Evangelization of Cuba." Ask God to equip every age group of Christians in each province with the power of the Holy Spirit to share the Gospel. *"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance"* (2 Peter 3:9, KJV).

#### **TUESDAY, June 30**
